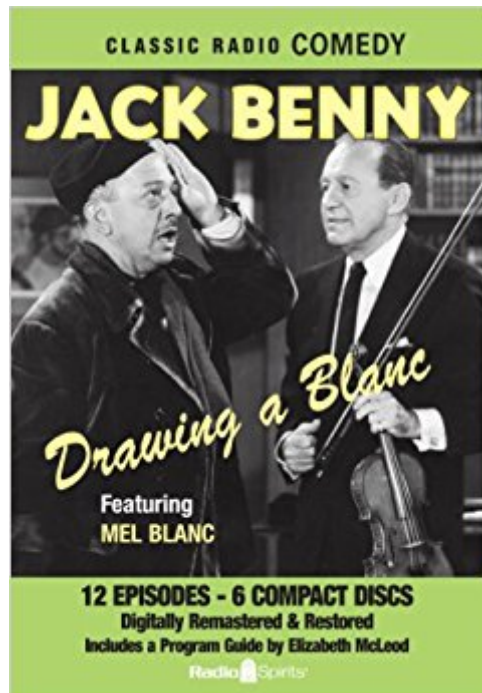

Synopsis

The Man of a Thousand Voices was Carmichael the Polar Bear, who lived improbably in Jack's cellar. He was Professor LeBlanc, Jack's violin teacher, whose French accent seemed to mimic every wail of his pupil's tortured strings. He was Polly the Parrot, Jack's impudent bird, who was less interested in crackers than in putting his master in his place. Utterly wonderful. Mel Blanc was a genius and the Jack Benny radio program was the peak of radio comedy -- far better than his TV shows. The best way to describe it is that the Jack Benny Show had humor carefully thought out with "callbacks" and various kinds of comedy techniques and humor VERY similar to the humor in the Warner Brothers cartoons. So it was quite fitting that Jack Benny worked closely with Mel Blanc. I listened to this set on a long drive and was laughing out loud. Blanc was an absolute comedy genius and if you go to You Tube you can see how he was equally great when seen by the camera. If you like cartoons and timeless comedy, this one is for you.
