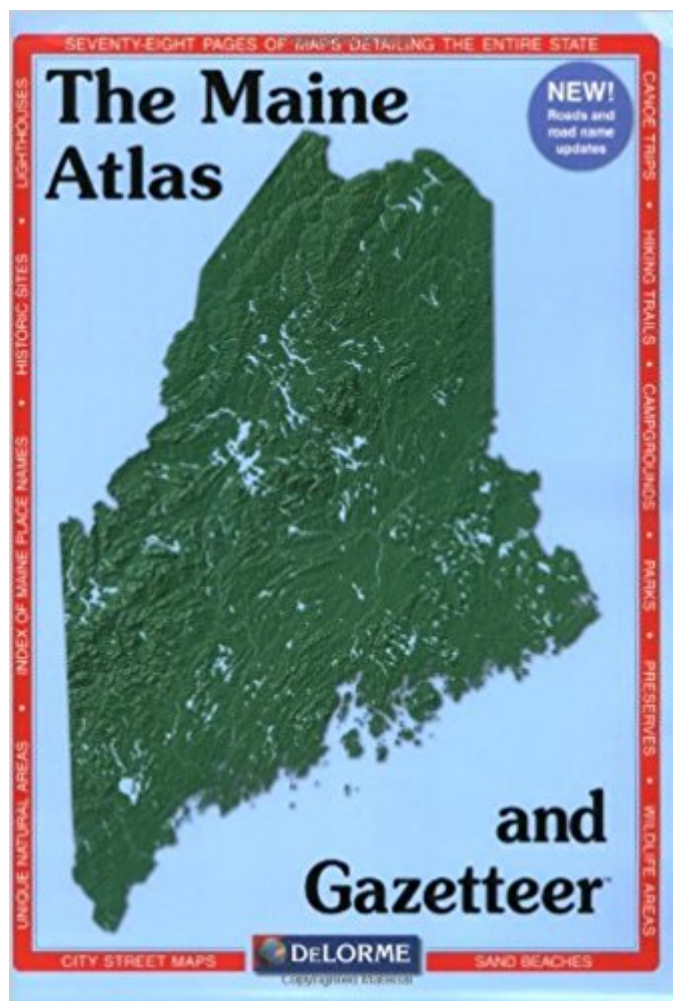

DeLorme has been directly responsible for many of the major technological advances made in the mapping industry over the past 30 years.

This is a must have for residents and visitors alike. I recently replaced my old 'car copy' from the pre-GPS days with the 2015 edition. My husband asked why I bought one when we have a GPS, and proceeded to spend an hour and a half flipping through the pages with me, looking at

recreational areas, outdoor activities, family outings, campgrounds, and unique natural features throughout the state. It's clear we have a lot of exploring to do, and you can be sure we will have our Delorme wherever we go.

Maine is the biggest of the New England states. It has more than its fair share of country roads, county roads, and back roads, many of which lead to the most interesting ponds, lakes, rivers, wildlife refuges, seacoasts, and other attractions. The DeLorme Maine Atlas and Gazetteer is just the right guide to the state, for the traveler or the resident. This atlas follows the usual DeLorme format, with a couple of big maps of the whole state; an index of place names; a listing of parks, campgrounds, and recreation areas; a map of all the townships in the state; and grid maps of the entire state. The back end of the atlas has close-up maps of the major population centers. The grid maps are in color and include height contour lines. The state has a surprising variety of nature reserves and public lands available for recreational use. All in all, this is a very useful atlas, and highly recommended.

I've had the New Hampshire Gazetteer for years, wearing it out with use. The Maine one is also great. It will go with me on my trip to Maine. One of the reasons I like these Delorme Gazetteers is that they are based on USGS topo maps. Show so many features.

I bought this before going to Maine for a week. It was immensely helpful not just for the information, but as a way to identify the basic geography of the State. Worth it if you plan on doing a lot of hiking!

These are the best maps for anyone who likes to travel off the paved road, (great on road too). I have heard that Garmin bought Delorme so I bought an extra map. I hope Garmin continues to publish these wonderful maps.

This book is a must have when traveling through the North Woods of Maine. GPS systems can easily get confused and with many logging roads, it can be easy to get lost. You need this book if traveling the back roads of Northern Maine, it has helped us immensely on more than one occasion.

Even though Maine is the best place on Earth, getting Google Maps isn't always a sure thing and this is one reason why the Gazetteer is necessary. It's also a really cool book.

I know that the days of paper maps are almost over, but this map is special. Not only does it show virtually every road in Maine, it is also filled with terrific ideas for things to do and places to visit. If you are coming to Maine, get one of these and spend the entire vacation exploring.
