

If you're going to purchase a book on logic games for the LSAT, this is the one to purchase. It's much easier to understand than Manhattan and has better strategies. You'll get a good foundation of the basics of logic games. However, I've found when I took the actual LSAT, the games are much more advanced. So my best suggestion is to devour the information in this book as best as you can, then take a practice exam using actual LSAT exams (Preptests), then practice, practice, practice some more. Do not rely solely on this book to help you pass the logic games section. You will do yourself a disservice if you use this book as a stand alone, without continuous practice using actual LSAT exams. You can purchase 10 New Actual, Official LSAT PrepTests exams on . Try to take a minimum of 20 preptests before your actual exam date.

This book is brilliant, I was struggling severely with the logic games section of the test, I purchased this book about two weeks ago and have been reading several chapters a night, I am a senior in college that will soon be applying to law school I am confident in stating that this purchase will be worth every penny, the author is so intuitive and explains the matter and hand in a crystal clear manner, I would recommend this to any one struggling with these mind boggling questions.

My mother convinced me to order a new copy of this book instead of a used one, so I spent \$8 more for the brand new copy. However, when I received it, I saw that the cover is noticeably worn and there is writing on several of the pages. I don't have time to send it back and get a new one, but

I am very unhappy with the quality of the product I received.

PowerScore provides a comprehensive system designed to help you attack the logic games section of the LSAT. However, reading this book is not sufficient to excel at logic games. Rather, after reading this book, students should take the skills they should learn and apply them (over and over again) to LSAC approved and non-approved logic games so you are proficient at using the tools the Logic Games Bible teaches when sitting for the LSAT.

Teaches you how to do the simple stuff, but it wasn't that great overall for me. This book may be useful for someone else, but personally I can't give it a rave review.

Great book. Goes very in depth yet is easy to follow and keeps you interested. Highly recommend as it is the best book for LSAT prep to date.

Decent book; I had not devoted any time to the LSAT, did a first practice test to set a baseline, scored 153 with most of the pain coming from the logic games section. Read/worked through this book, did a second sample test, scored 157. So, a cheap book got me five points with nowhere near the prep most people are putting in, and I'd consider that quite good. I still have a month before the test so I plan to actually start studying now, but hey, \$50 for arguably five points is pretty cost effective investment. My one complaint about the book is they seem to go overboard promoting their little trademarked terms for how to do things, like "Hurdle the Uncertainties." It gets old, and stupid, very quickly. Just an additional word of advice; I have the LSAT Hacks book that I bought as an explanation for tests 67-71, haven't read it yet as I haven't done those tests yet, but the diagramming methods that publisher uses for logic games differs from PowerScore's methods. So if you use that book after this one, you'll have to translate their explanations into PowerScore format so they make sense to you.

The PowerScore series for the LSAT are the best option for anyone studying for the LSAT. PowerScore walks you through every type of logic game available and gives you tips on time management. With this book in particular, I was able to improve my logic games section from about 12 correct to 20 correct on the LSAT. The PowerScore books were life-savers and I strongly encourage everyone to purchase these!
