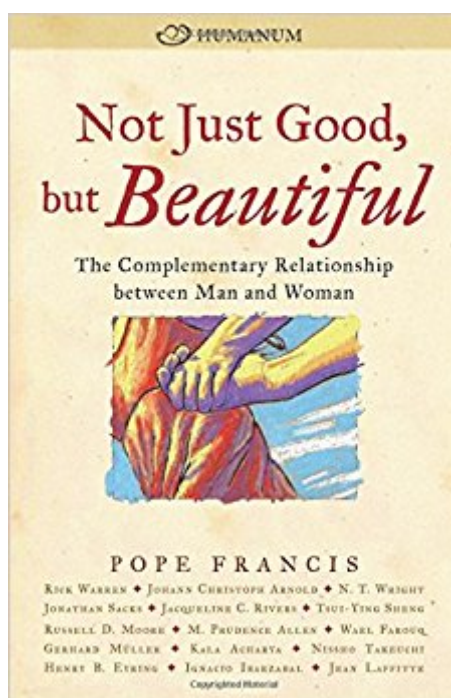


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# Not Just Good, But Beautiful: The Complementary Relationship Between Man And Woman
