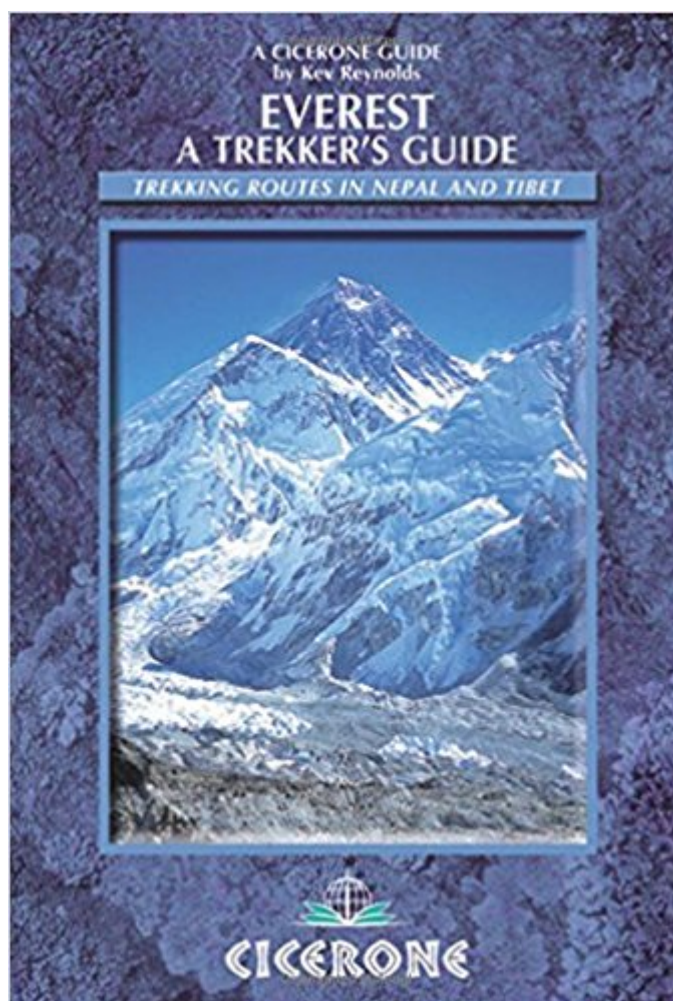

It is very well written from its descriptions of the various main and side treks to the feel within the teahouse lodges. I have not been there yet so I can't verify the accuracy but I'm very impressed. The book is also smaller than some guides and the paper quality seems superior to the others. It's great to see some beautiful color photos.
