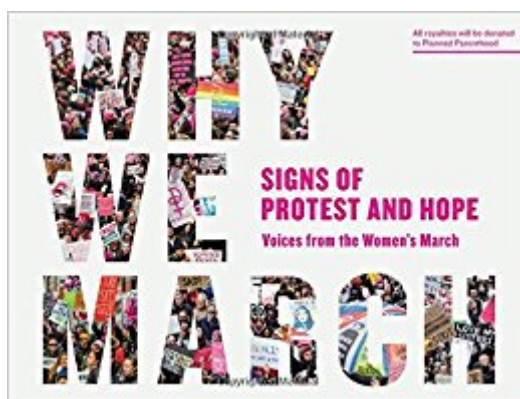


"The 500 photos predominantly feature protest signs from the powerful (written on the stripes of an American flag: "Love is love. Black lives matter. Climate change is real. Immigrants make America great. Women's rights are human rights.") to the funny ("Trump eats pizza with a fork!") to the simple ("UGH"). Interspersed with the photos are quotes from speeches given at the marches by powerful women.

These include politicians such as Elizabeth Warren and Kamala Harris, activists such as Janet Mock, Gloria Steinem, and Angela Davis, and celebrities such as Ashley Judd and Janelle Monáe. •Bust

The people's right to peacefully assemble and petition the Government for a redress of grievances is written in the 1st Amendment to the US Constitution. Those politicians who are trying to make such protests illegal and the protesters criminals disregard and disrespect our right to free speech.
