

Born in Guinea, author and playwright Djibril Tamsir Niane is a descendant of griots; African oral historians/storytellers. He translated Sundiata, as told by the griot Djeli Mamadou Kouyate, into French under the title Soundjata ou Epoque Mandingue in 1960. It was later translated into English by G. D. Pickett in 1965.

This is the best edition to get if you want to read about the Sundiata Keita legend and how the Malinke empire came into being. This new edition has a list of terms at the start to clarify for the reader about different cultural concepts. I would recommend it to djembe and dunun drummers who

study with West African teachers. They talk about the Sofa's (warriors) , Fakoly is mentioned and its told in the griot style that is generally clear enough to follow along. A good supplement to asking your teacher about the history of the Mande peoples.

I really enjoyed the story line of Sundiata and how it's told. It grabbed my attention immediately and I didn't want to put it down. However, it was very confusing to keep up with the numerous different names there are throughout the book.
