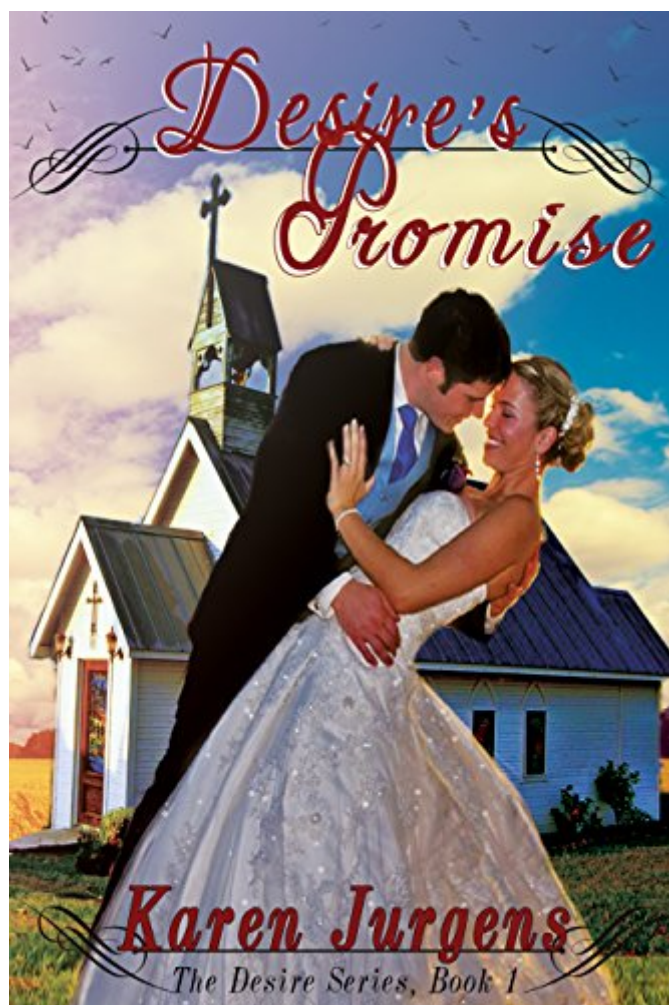

Her mother and father are going through a divorce and her mom does not want Carlie to experience the same fate. Carlie is truly in love with Lance though. Plus it further complicates the situation because Lance's twin, Meredith, is her best friend and college roommate. Carlie wants to trust God and she wants to positively influence Lance and her other friends to follow Christ. Can she do that or is God's job and not hers at all? Can she trust God to resolve the situation without her help? I don't think I've ever read a Christian romance written from this perspective and presented in the same fashion.
