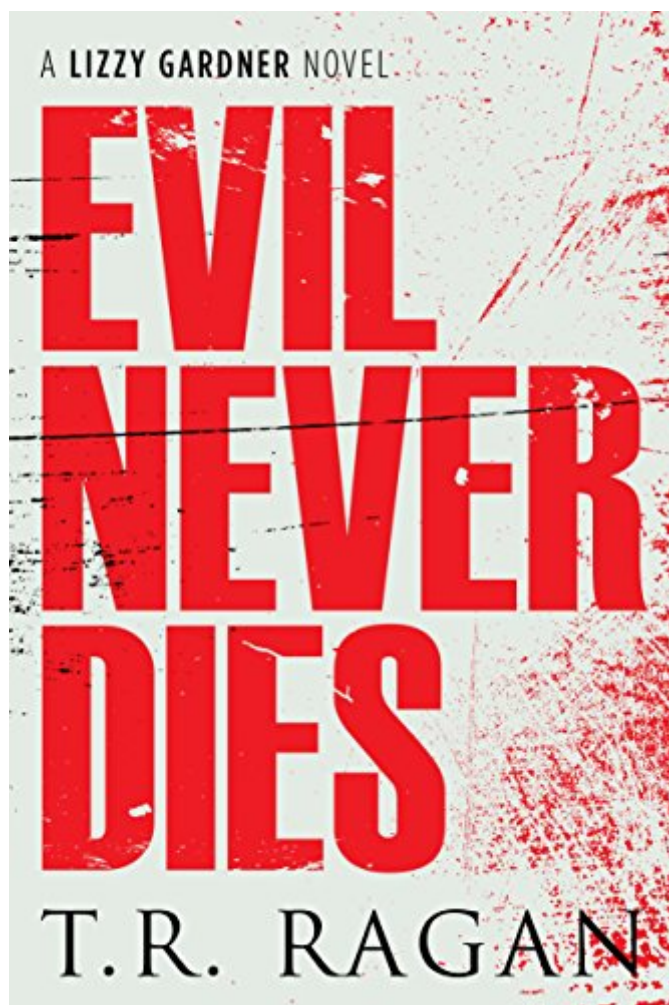


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Evil Never Dies (The Lizzy Gardner Series Book 6)

Well, it is over, the Lizzy Gardner Series. I have just read the last one in the series, *Evil Never Dies*. The book lives up to its name for sure and I just wish T.R. Ragan's writings were only fictional but I see in the paper every day that these events really take place. For you that were upset with the last two books of Theresa Ragan, you need to give this book a try. I felt that she went back to the beginning, dealing with the story lines and the characters as they were introduced into the series. As before, she keeps you in suspense, not in not knowing who the culprits are but what they will do next and how Lizzy will catch them and punish them. As in her other books, there are some surprises to look out for and some lives are changed forever. It has been a fun ride to read her series. I thank Theresa Ragan and look forward to her next series coming out soon.

I really did not like the change in the main character from the last book. The book seemed to have too much of hurting people. It seemed that once I got used to a character then it was 3-4 chapters before that character was on the pages again. However, I was happy to see Lizzie seem to accept finally the death of her fiancé. I like books where the main characters are carried forward from book to book. And T. R. Ragan does that quite nicely. All in all, this book was highly readable but, to me, it wasn't as good as the other Lizzie Gardner books.

I was hooked on the Lizzy Gardner series immediately after reading *Abducted*. I still am! Sad to see it over, but it was a great ending. A bunch of bad ass women, kicking a\$\$ and taking names! I do see possibilities for spin-offs. I would definitely like to see more of these characters, since Lizzy learns, *Evil Never Dies*!

I will miss Lizzy Gardner - she is a complex character (and so are the other characters in these books). I enjoyed reading all of the Lizzy Gardner books, yes, they were "dark", but complex, a challenge to understand and therefore interesting.

This, the final (for now, at least) book in the Lizzy Gardner series, shows our intrepid team fighting once again both external and internal demons and evil. There were no significant surprises but the stories were well written and meshed fairly well. My own favorite subplot was one involving Kitally, an old man named Gus, and an old woman named Betty doing battle against a crooked nursing home. I'd love to see a standalone on just this group. I'll continue to read Ms. Ragan's thrillers and look forward to her next series.
