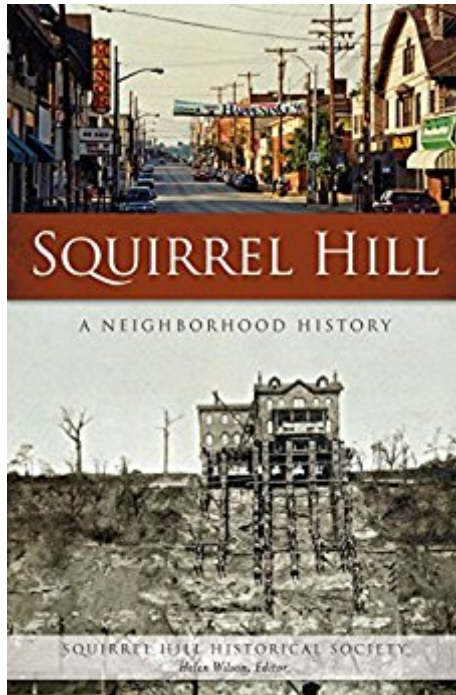

to its geological formations and the cultural heritage of Native American, French and British settlers. Later settlers included Jewish immigrants, making Squirrel Hill the heart of Pittsburgh's Jewish community.
