

Book 4 "The Descent into the Valley of Humiliation" A history of the latter part of Jesus' ministry from the Transfiguration to the journey to Jerusalem. Book 5 "The Cross and the Crown" A chronicle of each day of Passion Week, from Palm Sunday to the Resurrection. Appendices Valuable background material on Jewish history, tradition, and law"

Alfred Edersheim (1825-89) was a Vienna-born biblical scholar who converted from Judaism to Christianity. A veteran minister and missionary to the Jews of Romania, Edersheim left an enduring and priceless legacy to followers of Christ. Among his most widely read works are "The Life and Times of Jesus the Messiah, The Temple: Its Ministry and Services, " and "Bible History Old Testament.""

Never has a book so completely clarified the rabbinical treatment of Scriptures from The Assyrian Captivity to the 20th century. Scholarly but readable like a story. Can't imagine a pastor or serious student of Israel or the Bible being without it.

This is one of the great Christian classics! Great Jewish scholar Alfred Edersheim accepted Jesus of Nazareth as his Messiah, and shared his knowledge of the world in which Jesus lived in this book. The language may be a little difficult for some today, but it's well worth it. I find the book fascinating and very helpful. Very highly recommended!

And the fact that Edersheim was a former Orthodox Jew meant that he was a very well trained scholar and teacher of the scriptures. The book is very meaty with lots of details, but it thoroughly fills in the background of Jesus' day and also teaches a good deal about Judaism. I would highly recommend it for any seminary student.

The language can get a bit flowery but solid Biblical/Jewish thought that we are seldom exposed to in 21 century seminary graduates.

Edersheim is unsurpassed in his knowledge of primary source material relating to the historical

context of Jesus life, locations, deeds, and whereabouts. This book is daunting in its size, but well-worth the effort. In some respects, it gets better and better the further you go. It can really help bring you one step closer to the Jesus of the New Testament in his historical Jewish and Roman context. I read this book while referring frequently to Rose's book of Bible Maps and Charts, which has lots of nice maps of Israel, and have really grown in my understanding of the geography of Israel and biblical history as a result.
