

In this bedtime story, Mom is explaining the bedtime routine she shares with her daughter, Kayleigh.

Mom traces her steps as she tucks baby in for the night: warm bath, clean pajamas, hugs for toys and parents, before turning out the light. Then she shifts to a song and a prayer to God to keep baby safe. The latter part of the book revolves around what Mom will do if baby wakes and ends with a final prayer to God to keep baby safe. Readers should note that the book has a strong Christian focus. The illustrations are soft and rather charming, contributing to the mood that I believe the author intended. I feel that the text reads more like a letter or stream of consciousness rather than a story. Parents who read the book as a bedtime story might want to tailor it to suit their own family situation.

I've been review blogging for about 5 years now...and whenever it comes to a children's book that I am reviewing...I ALWAYS make it a joint review...myself and whichever of my two youngest children also read the book. To me, sure it's important that I like the book, but IT'S SO MUCH MORE IMPORTANT THAT MY CHILD LIKES THE BOOK AND THAT HE TAKES SOMETHING AWAY FROM IT, EVEN IF IT'S JUST A GOOD FEELING IN HIS HEART....and this is the case with RyAnn Hall's NIGHT, NIGHT, MY CHILD...Here is Nathan and I's review:~~~~~This book is a really cute and simple book for really young children and beginning readers. My son, Nate and I read it before he went to bed Wednesday night, and I'm proud to say...IT WAS A HIT!! Meaning, we will be reading it again. Nate really liked the part that it included that you give your puppy kisses before you go to bed...because (s)he NEVER goes to bed without kissing his Nucky. Mommy liked the part where (s)he saves some of his hugs and kisses for Mommy. Because we all know that Mommy's CAN NEVER get enough hugs and kisses from our little ones. Nate really thought it was great that the book talked about Mommy rubbing his/her back until he fell asleep, because this is most definitely one of our nightly rituals.
