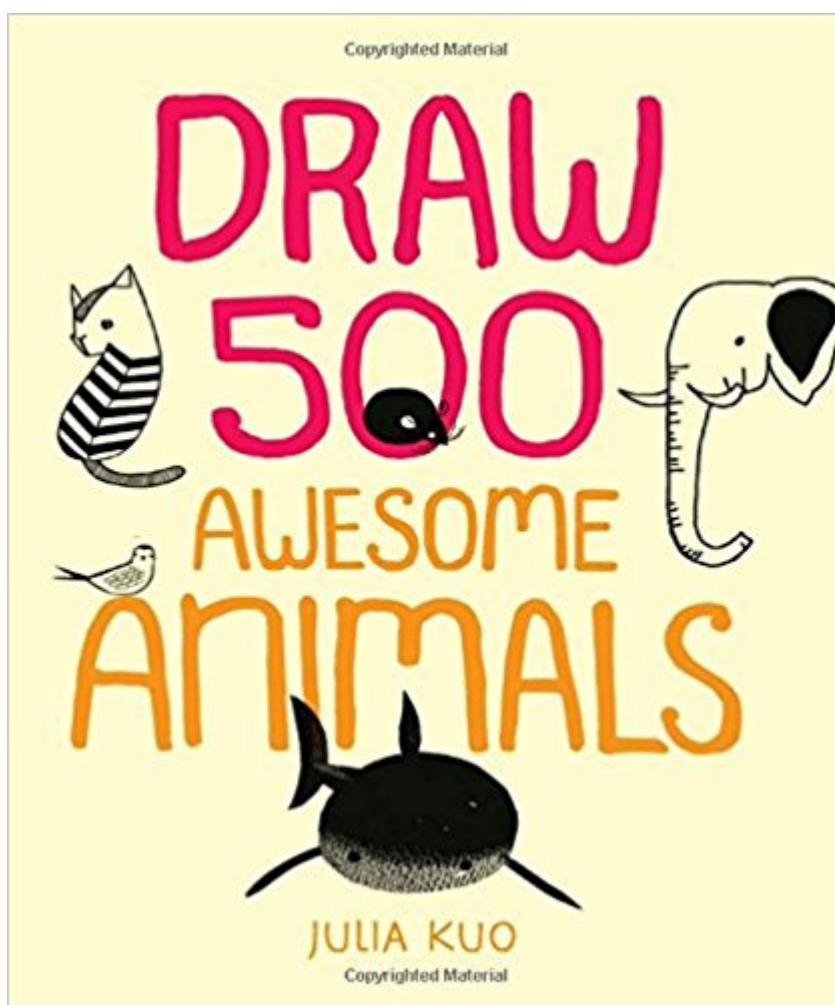

"This series takes a novel, minimalist approach to art instruction. Each "20 Ways" title provides 45 spreads that are each filled with 20 small drawings on a given theme. Readers will find no step-by-step exercises here; however, each spread offers a variety of styles and techniques. Drawings range from the realistic to the cartoonish to the decorative, with a few rendered in color.

The variety of drawing types is intended to inspire readers to experiment on their own. Aspiring artists can either copy drawings directly from the book or create their own variations on a theme. The latest two volumes in the series focus on nature and animals. "20 Ways To Draw a Tree" presents many sophisticated, modern drawings of plants and flowers, executed with a surprising array of materials. Despite the title, "20 Ways To Draw a Cat" includes all sorts of animals, such as hedgehogs, buffalo, fish, and zebras. This book is very small. However, it was a hit with my 8 year old daughter who loves to draw animals. It does not give step by step directions for drawing the animals. It just shows a very simplified drawing that is easy to copy. I wasn't thrilled with this book, but it is what the description says it is. I would recommend this for a child, however I think an adult purchasing this for themselves would be disappointed.

This book just shows pictures of animals to draw- there are no "how tos." You could probably find all the designs on a Google search.

I thought there would be step-by-step instructions on how to draw these awesome animals. It's a book with whole drawings of animals, no instructions, which for my needs, made the awesome animal drawings, not so awesome.

This is a book of drawings and not teaching you how to draw however the drawings use basic

shapes and techniques that any kid or beginning drawer can follow and replicate. wish book was cheaper though. it is also ver small book.

I have given this book to four different children ranging in ages from 5 to 10 and it has an instant effect of stimulating them to draw. The images are designed and stylized in a way that children can relate to compared to most books on how to draw animals. Mostly they have instructions with a lot of circles and then immediately superimpose an extremely realistic, complicated drawing that most children can't relate to. I was a professional artist/designer and can highly recommend this book for children. It keeps them entranced for hours!
