

I found this book quite enjoyable and yet often was left wanting more detail on something than was stated. Many a time the author seemed to go into great detail with less important matters than on extremely historic moments in the life of the royals. Despite this, I did enjoy the book overall and

found it well researched complete with images I had never seen before and cannot imagine the royal family being too pleased to see. Alas, for a former monarchist turned republican the book merely served to enhance my desire to one day see England as a Republic. I think most people who want to read more than the frills of royalty would enjoy this book. It's meaty, but not too much so.

Kelley does her research!

I had been wanting to read this for many years but never got around to it until recently. This book wasn't quite as scandalous as I was expecting it to be (though there are some naughty anecdotes and details). Kitty did a good job of giving a historical context of the British monarchy before going into details about selected family members. Much of the book focuses on Queen Elizabeth II and the late Princess Diana. Their respective courtships and marriages are discussed in great detail as are some of the scandals and behind the scenes dramas some of us may have known nothing about. The book is thoroughly engaging and well-written.
