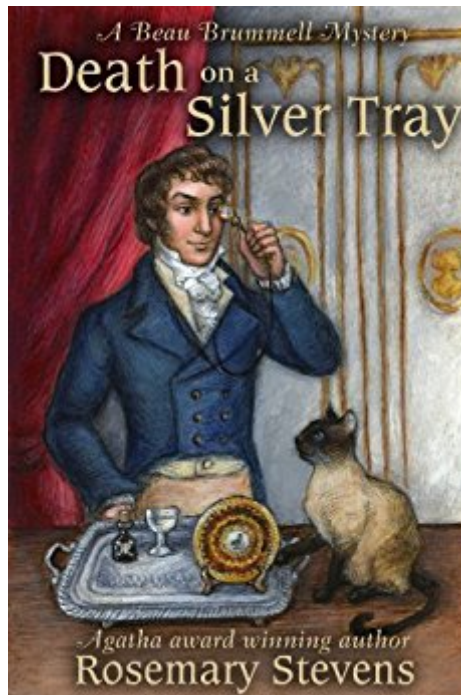

This Regency historical mystery casts dandy supreme Beau Brummel as a crime solver. His great friend the Duchess of York has recommended a lady's maid to a friend and she is the prime suspect in the murder of that odious woman. To protect her reputation, Beau steps into to find the real culprit. I did enjoy the mystery, I did enjoy the cat, I am not sure I enjoyed the cat being so key in pointing out clues. I will be putting the next on my to read list, but am not totally sold just yet.

Beau Brummell decided what and who was fashionable in Regency England. Most Regencies describe him as a rather one dimensional character. Ms. Stevens has quite rightly made him the center of a mystery series, much as he was the center of the fashionable world of his time. He is asked by his dear friend, the Duchess of York, to clear a protegee of hers of the murder of her employer. The woman was exceedingly unpleasant, and was even rumored to have beaten her servants. The night before her death, Lady Wrayburn was incensed with Miss Ashton for inadvertantly telling her that her ladies' maid was pregnant. Now all of London thinks that Miss Ashton is the murderer. To save the Duchess' reputation and to assist the young women, the Beau agrees to help. He even loses a painting at auction, having been distracted by the problem. The winner of the auction, a representative of the King of Siam, presents him with the first Siamese cat in England. The famous valet, Robinson, is not happy about cat hairs, but Brummell can not return him. The cat seems to be an ancestor of Lillian Jackson Braun's KoKo, an able assistant in solving a difficult murder. This was an excellent mystery. The characters are familiar ones for those who have read regencies, and very well developed. The mystery was engrossing and difficult to solve. I am looking forward to reading the next book in the series.

Fun Regency style mystery with the added charm of placing Beau Brummel as the detective in a society murder case. A quick and light read, the author obviously did her research in placing her characters' voices in the language and tone of the period without the annoyance of lapsing into present-day conversational style as sometimes happens in historical novels. Hlghly recommend for a pleasant Regency romp.

In this first book of the Brummell mysteries, we find the Beau going about society as usual and acquiring the only Royal Siamese Cat in England. He then becomes involved in a public scene which later turns into murder. The author has a very deft touch with Regency manners, more's and affectations. Her research is well done and her characters are in keeping with the historical figures that they are based on. Very enjoyable light mystery.

I found the first of the Beau Brummel series enjoyable, especially since discovering he was a real person -- as were most of the characters in the book. The mystery was good, but I especially liked the details of living as Nobility in Regency England. The main character is witty, his valet his long-suffering and funny. I liked the addition of the cat to the household and the angst he causes the valet. I've since read two more in the series. They should be read in order.

I was prepared to just graze and pass on this one but i got caught in it and enjoyed it very much. The asides and unspoken "comments really brought a simple story to life. The interplay between the "ordinary" folk and the nobility brings "Downton Abbey to mind. There is no doubt that the aristocracy serves little purpose is quite shallow.
