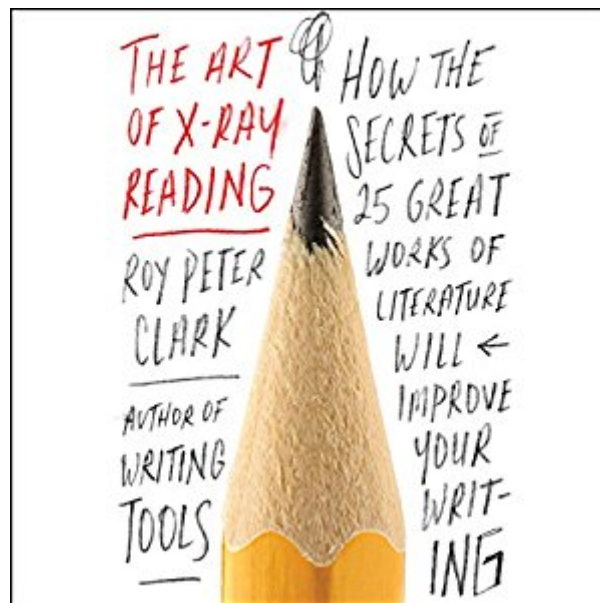

This is a useful book for us readers as well as for writers. Roy Peter Clark gives examples, advice, some suggestions and rules on what to look for beyond the text and plot, into the heart and soul of a book. The examples are well chosen and explained well. He writes for journalists, novelists and for us ordinary folk who want to read well and write well. X-raying is a good metaphor, for what Clark is expounding. The word "x-ray," though, is a bit overused, chapter after chapter. This is a minor criticism, though. Happily, the book uses ordinary language, not the jargon of literary criticism or those slippery post modern terms. This is a good reference book for me, too full of good stuff to read only once. I intend to keep it handy for reference and enlightenment.

The Art of X-Ray Reading by Roy Peter Clark is another of his wonderful books. I like how he uses examples from his life in his writing about how to read slowly and carefully in order to improve your writing. What you read, of course, makes a difference. Clark has chosen those books which he both grew up with and more recent books to show how "x-ray reading" works. Clark's humor makes for enjoyable reading. I learned much from this book.
